





Detectable Watermarks in the Vienna Logic transcript – Request for Help

The following photographs of the watermarks in the *Vienna Logic* manuscript were kindly produced by a member of the staff of the University Library of Vienna (Austria). The information previously

provided by Gerhard Lehmann proves to be incorrect (Ak. XXIV: : >eagle and imperial orb with cross<). According to the library staff member, no eagle is visible. Rather, the watermark appears to consist of a coat of arms containing in one half an imperial orb surmounted by a cross, above which there is a crown with ornamental decoration (identified as an eagle by Lehmann). Unfortunately, it has not yet been possible to identify either this watermark or the letter combination shown. We would therefore be very grateful for any assistance from readers, since in the case of this anonymous transcript the watermark constitutes an important piece of evidence for determining both the date of manufacture and the possible place of production.
