Legal Drugs: Include any drugs used for a medical purpose. **Medicines** are legal drugs (typically prescribed by a doctor or sold in stores or pharmacies)

Example: Tylenol

Illegal Drugs: drugs used for any purpose other than the intended purpose

Example: Marijuana, Ecstasy, Cocaine, LSD, Crystal Meth, Heroin
