

Classroom Rules for Ms. Katona's English Class

****Listed below are the classroom rules that you will follow every day in my class. If everyone follows these rules, our class can run smoothly and we will not have any problems.**

REMINDER: All rules outlined in the student handbook also apply to my classroom. You must follow those rules AND the rules listed below.

1. If you are not in your seat when the bell rings, you are tardy for the day.

This means that if you are in the classroom but not in your seat, you are tardy. If you receive three tardies for the semester, you will receive a detention. For every three tardies you will receive one detention.

2. Show respect in the classroom.

This means that when I am talking, you should not be talking. If you have something to say, do not shout it out. Raise your hand in class. If one of your classmates is talking, that means you will not be talking and paying attention to what they have to say.

3. If you are absent, you will have two days to make up the work missed that day.

For example, if you miss Monday, you will receive the work you have to make up on Tuesday, and will have until Wednesday to make up that work. If you have an unexcused absence, you will not be able to make up the work for the day missed.

4. Late work will not be accepted!

Homework must be turned in on the day it is due. You must have your homework in class by the time the bell rings. You will not be allowed to leave class after the bell rings in order to get your homework, so please make sure you have your homework with you at the beginning of class! If you are absent, you must turn in your homework the day you come back.

5. Always have materials needed for class.

You should have a pen or pencil and your notebook every day in class. If you need your literature book, language book or a novel we are reading, I will let you know the day before and it will be posted on the board. You must have all materials before class begins. Once class starts, you will not be allowed to go back to your locker to retrieve materials.
